(OPTION #2) June 25-29 Three great days of fishing: all day Tuesday, all day Wednesday, and Thursday until 6 PM. Leave Monday June 25th We'll spend the night near Rennie, Manitoba, so we can get in the water early Tuesday. Return on Friday. June 29th **Cost: \$495.**

(OPTION #3) June 22-29 Six and a half days of unbelievable fishing at a more relaxed paced: Friday PM through Thursday 6 PM. Leave Friday 4 AM June 22th. Return the following Friday June 29th **Cost: \$925.**



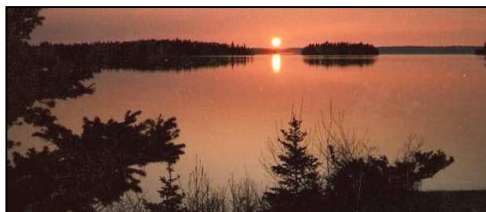
FEES: Prices quoted above are based on the equivalent of twenty fully-paid fishermen (ten per trip options 1 & 2 and are subject to change until deposit is paid. Fees include comfortable accommodations in modern cabins (linens supplied), on Options 1 & 3 Bring sleeping bag on option 2, delicious food, fully-equipped boats with newer motors, exceptional dock service. Each fisherman will be responsible for his own tackle, and license, as well as meals and fuel expenses to and from Canada. Detailed packing, rigging, and travel instructions will be provided well in advance of each trip. **IMPORTANT: PASSPORT or PASSPORT CARD REQUIRED.** Allow two months if you need to secure a passport or update your present passport. (REQUIRED: Release of liability form has to be signed, notarized, and returned with final payment on May 1st. Limited space available for retreats. First come first serve policy. Crow Duck is the largest lake in Whiteshell Provincial Park (eastern Manitoba) about 80 miles north of the US border and two hours east of Winnipeg. Since there are no roads to Crow Duck, owner Bill Kolansky will pick us up on Big Whiteshell Lake. From there it's a two-mile boat ride to a private trail that leads to the camp. The two-mile truck ride thru wilderness bush country is a refreshing end to the journey and an exciting beginning to our vacation. Crow Duck is a remote lake with no roads, no private cabins, and nothing but fantastic fishing and spectacular scenery. "Come join us for a memorable week of fishing in the Canadian Wilderness," invites the Crow Duck staff, "and let us prove to you that we have the BEST lake, BEST Camp, and BEST service of any Lodge in Canada!"

WALLEYES Crow Duck Lake has awesome fishing! Walleyes were first stocked in Crow Duck Lake in 1986 and are now a reproducing permanent species. They have done VERY WELL! Expect to catch large numbers of quality fish (average size 20"). Our experience over a ten year period is that on a typical day, approximately 40 to 75 walleyes are caught per day per person on Crow Duck Lake. Crow Duck Lake's Catch & Release walleye designation gives all fisherman the opportunity to experience excellent fishing, as good as can be found in Wilderness Canada. We'll hike on over to Saddle Lake or Side Saddle to fill our limits so we can take some home as well as cook up a tasty Canadian shore lunch.

SMALLMOUTH "If you are after lunker bass, Crow Duck Lake is your dream come true!" says the owner. "Bass fishing is fantastic here, in June. Expect to catch lots of nice bass and you have an excellent chance of finding a 'Master Angler Award' (18" or more) bass here." The lake has excellent bass habitat with 75 miles of rocky shoreline, underwater rock piles, and many weed beds.

Since there are no roads to Crow Duck, Bill Kolansky will pick us up on Big Whiteshell Lake. From there it's a two-mile boat ride to a private trail that leads to Crow Duck Lake. The two-mile truck ride thru wilderness bush country is a scenic ride to the lake and an exciting beginning to our fishing. Crow Duck is a remote lake with no roads, no private cabins, and nothing but fantastic fishing and spectacular scenery.

WALLEYES Crow Duck Lake has awesome fishing! Walleyes were first stocked in Crow Duck Lake in 1986 and are now a reproducing permanent species. They have done VERY WELL! Expect to catch large numbers of quality fish (average size 20"). It is very common to catch 100+ walleyes per day per boat. Our 2010 group of 10 caught 600+ in our three and a half days of fishing! Crow Duck Lake's Catch & Release walleye designation gives all fisherman the opportunity to experience excellent fishing, We'll hike on over to Saddle Lake to fill our limits so we can take some home as well as cook up a tasty Canadian shore lunch.
